What qualities d o they need to become a self-employed / employed Live-in Carer?

Most of our clients packages are vulnerable and many are confused or in poor health, so they must be capable of patience and good humour at all times.

Carer will be a genuinely compassionate person; always dependable and with plenty of common sense.

- Each will need to be physically fit enough to assist your clients with bathing or to push them in their wheelchair.
- Should be a reasonable cook and be able to prepare English meals.
- Must be happy to do housework and laundry and to keep the home they are staying in clean and tidy.
- Being able to understand, speak and write English to a high standard.
- Good communication is essential.

How many hours will they be expected to work in a Live-in Care job?



As a self-employed/ employed live in carer, they will probably work an average of eight to ten hour day, where you are in contact with the Carer; but they'll need to be on hand to help the client if needed. They are usually required to work seven days a week.

Each Carer should always arrange to have a two-hour break off the premises each day and also never be expected to work through the night Should a client need support throughout the night, then the Client or their family would be expected to make arrangements with us for these periods.

Our 24/7 living in care service is shaped by each individual client's situation and needs. We aim to promote your clients independence and enable them to have freedom of choice through one-to-one support.

Live in Care Job payment

The carer is paid every week, by the Client or Care Seeker or we can assist you when required in payroll after the care, support or companionship has been delivered.

Our live-in carers will be paid the stated rate on their profile, unless an increase is agreed by all parties. The client or Care Seeker will pay the Carer depending on the level of dependency one of the 3 levels of payment we have for example low £550.00, Medium £620.00 and High £700.00 each week, for the duration of the assignment.

The figures above are the total payment you would pay including any fees and payment to Carer.

To retain their self-employed status it is important that our carers have different live in care jobs most would have completed 5 to 10 different jobs each year.

- Birth certificate
- National insurance number
- Valid photographic driving license
- Details of there Skills & Experience
- Carers full CV with up-to-date working history
- References and training certificates
